

### Using the Preferential Voting System, the results are as follows:

At the first count, no nominee received at least 51% of the total votes returned. As Kasia had the least amount of votes 105, her voters SECOND CHOICE preferences were distributed to the remaining candidates. (Some voters only showed their first preference and so their votes become invalid for 2<sup>nd</sup> and subsequent counts).

At the second count, Howard Phillips received 62.62% of the total votes returned and is therefore elected.


